

To ensure that the copyright is properly attributed, please save each copyright release form as a PDF using the following naming convention and upload to the link below: NUMERICALSEQUENCE_TCA_FIRSTAUTHORFAMILYNAME_CONFERENCENAME

e.g., 002_TCA_KHALIFA_COEC2021. The FirstAuthorFamilyName should be the same used in the article file name.

HOW TO UPLOAD REPLACEMENTS AND COPYRIGHT FORMS

You should upload your replacement files and copyright forms in separate folders but in one ZIP/RAR file to Seafile (https://seafile.aip.org/u/d/4c55ddd7de784a199acf/) and send a confirmation email to <u>aiocoeo@aip.org</u> once the upload is complete. The ZIP/RAR file should be labeled ACRONYM_date uploaded. [NOTE – if fewer than 10 files, send as email attachments].
